- o DAR Form (NAVY only) if the service member is being command or incident referred.

The following items are needed by every patient requesting treatment:

- SARP registration form reflecting the recommended level of treatment.
- * SHAPES physical that has been completed and signed by a medical provider *
- o SARP has the service member's mental health or substance abuse assessment.
 - This exam must be completed by a Licensed Independent Practitioner: NP, MD, PHD, LCSW, PA
- * SARP has received TAD orders for the entirety of treatment *
- Patient's appointments, minus any legal appointments, have been completed or rescheduled until after the completion of treatment.
