

What is GTP?

GTP is a low-bandwidth, secure web-based, world-wide, teleconsultation system GTP which supports AFRICOM, CENTRCOM, EUCOM, PACOM, SOUTHCOM, AFRICOM, SOUTHCOM, Fleet and Marine Assets, as well as MTFs both CONUS and CONUS.



Many of these MTFs have limited to no access to local specialty consultation services. GTP Provides 90 subspecialties at your finger tips with average response times in under 24 hours.

- Improves access to care in remote locales with 90% of consults answered within 24 hours.
- Provides quality subspecialty care to patients in remote locations where local expertise is unavailable or limited. Made for ships at sea or providers alone and afraid.

The system allows teleconsultation, requests for patient movement, finding an accepting provider, real time status updates.

Place on a consult using your computer or your personal cell phone.

GTP allows remote providers to submit clinical questions, photos, short videos, radiology images/videos, pathology reports, and any multimedia you can think of.

The platform provides medical professionals all over the world to directly communicate with each other and receive feedback in less than 24 hours.
