

MASK POLICY UPDATE



Due to the steady decrease in COVID-19 cases, patients, visitors, and staff will no longer be required to wear a mask within our facilities, with the below exceptions.

The following circumstances require a mask:

- Persons with suspected or confirmed COVID-19 infection or other respiratory symptoms (e.g., runny nose, cough, sneezing, fever).
- Those who have had close contact with a COVID-19 infected person within the last 10 days.
- Those who have been advised by a medical provider or public health authority to wear a mask.

Mask wearing remains strongly encouraged and masks will continue to be provided at the main entrances. If you would like your provider to wear a mask during your appointment, please let them know.
