



Naval Medical Center Portsmouth Visitor and Masking Policy

At Naval Medical Center Portsmouth (NMCP), the safety of our staff and patients is our highest priority.

As we continue to monitor our local COVID-19 trends, we will continue to update our visitor and masking policies.



Patients are permitted healthy visitors only (Visitors must be free from fevers, coughs, and shortness of breath).



Patients and visitors, ages 2 and older, are required to wear a face mask if you have:

- Suspected or confirmed COVID-19 infection or other respiratory symptoms (e.g., runny nose, cough, sneezing, fever).
- Been in close contact with a COVID-19 infected person within the last 10 days.
- Been advised by a medical provider or public health authority to wear a mask.



Visitors must wash their hands or use hand sanitizer when entering and exiting patient rooms.

- In-person visitation is not permitted for COVID-19 confirmed patients.
- End-of-life situations will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis.
