**Psychological Testing Guidelines**

TBI Services, Neuropsychology can evaluate and interpret NEUROCOGNITIVE TESTING (to diagnose neurocognitive issues caused by brain injuries or in conjunction with mental illness).

PSYCHOLOGICAL TESTING is available to differentiate between psychiatric diagnoses. Our psychometrists will conduct the actual testing; however, an Adult Mental Health clinical psychologist will be responsible for ordering and interpreting the results.

**For Psychological Testing:**

(ADHD, Intelligence, low performance validity and Personality)

Place consult to MH NEUROPSYCHOLOGY with description of patient presentation and need for diagnostic clarity. The referral for testing must include the NAME AND CONTACT INFORMATION FOR THE PSYCHOLOGIST WHO WILL BE INTERPRETING THE TESTING and the LIST OF TESTS TO BE ADMINISTERED (see below for available tests). Tests will then be scheduled and completed, and results will be loaded into DoDSAFE for review and interpretation by the psychologist of your choosing. The referring psychologist will be notified upon completion of testing. **\*\*A suicide risk assessment MUST be completed within 48 hours of testing and referring psychologist MUST be available by phone during testing session\*\*.**

- Wechsler Adult Intelligence Scale (WAIS-IV)
