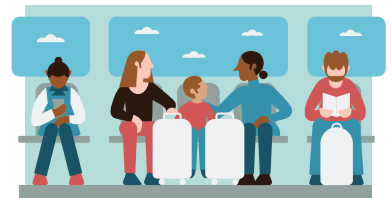
NO REFERRAL NEEDED
